An Invitation from Presiding Overseer Jim Anderson



By definition, all of Christ's servants are running a marathon. The Apostle Paul compares a believer's lifetime of ministry to running a race in Acts 20:24, I Corinthians 9:24, Galatians 2:2, 5:7 and II Timothy 4:7. The writer of Hebrews also uses this beautiful analogy in Hebrews 12:1. Paul makes it clear in

Acts 20:24 that the great passion of his life is finishing his race well. He declares:

I consider my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the gospel of God's grace.

“Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us...”

Hebrews 12:1

This year's theme for Harvest Network's regional retreats will center on this great analogy. We will look at how we discern the path the Lord progressively reveals for our unique race. How we can discover and maintain a healthy pace remembering this is a marathon, not a sprint. We will talk about avoiding the things that can trip us up: sin, Satan and even good alternative paths. Finally, we will touch on the fact that most of us are actually running a relay race. To whom will you hand the baton when your laps are completed?

Let's run with endurance the race that the Lord sets before us! I urge you to come away to be renewed and encouraged in your race and cheer others on in completing theirs.
